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**LPA adds signage to help Visitors find Alternate Parking**

During the temporary closure of the Annex Garage, the Lexington Parking Authority is working to help downtown visitors more easily find parking. The Lexington Parking Authority has added signage on Main Street, MLK Blvd. and Limestone directing drivers to alternate parking locations, please see the attached images on page 2 for examples.

The Annex Garage has been closed since November 5<sup>th</sup>, and will remain closed until late spring 2013. The closure will allow restoration work to continue at a faster pace to expedite re-opening.

Construction began in August on the \$3.1 million dollar restoration to the garage, built in the mid to late 1960s. The restoration involves needed safety repairs, including waterproofing, lighting updates, and a new entry/exit system.

- Courthouse Garage, enter at 105 Barr Street
